Are you a man who's living with HIV and doing great? We might have a job for you as a squad manager!

Think back to the moment you learned that you had HIV. For a lot of men, it feels like life is over. But Coach Mpilo knows that isn't true. It's possible to live a happy, healthy, normal life with HIV.

The Coach Mpilo programme employs men living well with HIV as coaches to give advice and support to men who are struggling to adjust to life with HIV and need to talk to someone who has been there.

Coaches reach out to men living with HIV in their communities, give them advice and support for starting and staying on HIV treatment, and work together with the clinic to make sure their men continue to do well.

We're recruiting a new team of coaches to be based in the City of Johannesburg, and they'll need a squad manager to help them stay at peak performance.

Here's what we are looking for:

- · A man who is living with HIV and has been on treatment for at least a year
- · A man who is open and confident about his HIV status, and rejects any HIV stigma
- A man who enjoys training and mentoring people and building a strong team
- A man who can also handle the admin and reporting requirements of the programme

What does squad manager do?

- Recruits, trains, manages and supports a team of 20-25 coaches
- Coordinates with the clinics in his area to ensure a good working relationship with his coaches
- · Coordinates with the programme manager to ensure admin and reporting requirements are met

Experience and qualifications:

- Experience managing programmes and people, ideally in the health or social development sector
- · Good written and oral communication skills
- · Completion of matric or higher
